This month I thought we would take a walk through the preemie-sick baby department so you can see the faces of the little ones and some of the people who look after them. Joy is senior mum in this department and has been investing love and prayers into these little ones for well over 20 years. Thank you Mumma Joy!!! All these mums pictured are very loving to the babies. They are joined nearly every day by Mike our driver & Pastor John for playtime, plus worship and prayer for them all. Love and prayer changes the course of their lives.

We see little ones go from near death to healthy vibrant trouble makers once they start to crawl or walk. It is very rare for us to lose a child now that there is good medical care available in Jinja. Good medical care was hard to find in 2003 when I took over the orphanage. We did many long trips to Kampala. About a month after I got to Jinja Dr Ian Clark the Irish founder of International Hospital in Kampala started International Medical Clinic in Jinja with the needs of the orphans on his mind. Thank you Dr Clarke!! Before 2003 the death rate at the home was between 5 to 10 a month. We have lost less than 20 children since 2004 - they came to us so very late in their illness that they did not have the strength left in them to fight any more, even with the best medical care we could provide.

We are "adopting pigs" below the clinic to breed & raise money for Medical Clinic salaries. You will hear more when we get the sty built. We have lots of food peelings and scraps to feed them all.

Thank you for your love and support that touches the lives of so many in desperate need.
