Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

This past month has been good for us. The Ebola Epidemic which is most often deadly, has been officially declared over!!! All the small medical clinics are allowed to re-open, and our medical ministry team are now at work without restrictions. This is a blessing to those in need, especially the small children and elderly as they suffer the most.

The 2 village churches in Lwambogo and Kamigo are now fully functioning after being on lock down because of Ebola being so close to them.

Every child that enters our home is brought by a government agency, then a Court process. We name all incoming abandoned children with the surname of **Mukisa** which means Beloved of God. You can see the beginning of Ethan's Journey into the home when he arrived with the officers from about 50 miles away from the city of Kamule. Joseph came in because his mother died and his dad cannot afford to look after a baby. Hopefully when Joseph is 3 yrs we will be able to restore him to dad. Joan came because mum died after her birth, dad unknown and Aunt could not afford to look after her. Prayerfully Aunt will be in a position to look after her at 3 yrs. We will see if a small interest free business loan will work to help her.

Our children and staff are doing very well. We thank you for partnering with us in the ministry to the needy children of Uganda. We are recognized in the Jinja community as a ministry of mercy. Your generosity touches many lives with over 95% of all donations going to Uganda. Newsletters are our main U.S. expense. No Westerner is paid any salary - we volunteer. July marks 20 years for me.
