It has been a busy time for our village medical team for Betty our Social Worker along with sisters Tabitha and Stacia our very gifted long term volunteers from the US. They all have a heart for the suffering children in the villages and are patiently waiting for the medical clinic (pictured on the left) in Lwambogo to open. They are more than ready to move into their office/store room which will hold formula and garden seeds plus other needed items. The clinic will help them a lot with the work they do as medical care for many of the children will be given right there in the village. Despite COVID they have had a very fruitful time caring for the suffering children from many of the surrounding villages. On the right we see the young family they are working with to get their son the care he needs. He will have his cleft surgery at CoRSU hospital in Entebbe. They take wonderful care of these little ones. On the left is one of his relatives who had a terrible skin condition which is now healed up. They found these 2 little ones in the family of the young girl they had cared for who died from Jaw cancer. We gave this young girl some joy with some toys and books, coloring pencils, and also some balls so she could play with her cousins. The village had shunned her because they thought her cancer was contagious. Our team made sure she had food that she liked and could eat. It is sad that it was far too late when she came for medical care.
