We have had 3 new little ones join us in July. Twins Phiona and Jovan while their mum has a surgery and time to recover. Also Maria who comes from a difficult background of dad in prison and mum with mental health issues. Pray for peace for all 3 as they settle in as it's a big adjustment.

The pictures on the left are of the same young boy Charles struggling to survive. After much intervention from our village social work team you can see the huge difference medical care and nutrition can make. The change in his eyes from haunted suffering to the sparkle of a happy life is wonderful to see. Charles has stayed with his family and not needed admission to the home. It is your faithful support that made this transformation and many others like it possible. Thank you so much!!!

The work on the medical clinic is at a standstill because of the lock down and also the need for green timber to finish drying. The vegetable garden below the clinic and some trees in the orchard have been planted It will all help many children needing nutrition.

The SOS orphanage medical team are checking some of our older children preparing them to transfer to their Entebbe facilities where they will meet several friends from WH. They will be raised up through their schooling and out into the work force.
