We were able to bring over in total 30 bags X 50lb of much needed supplies for the orphanage and some of the needed things for the new medical clinic. We really appreciate all who sew for us. This trip it was mostly lovely blankets from St Johns in Corona, and dresses and blankets from Calvary Chapel in Yorba Linda who also from a fund raiser sent us with a lot of new clothes, shoes and school supplies. We were able to take many shoes to the children in the village who had none. We really appreciate all your wonderful help and generosity.

The clinic preparations are moving ahead as the Covid restrictions on our building crew are lifted and also the timber is now dry enough to have the doors, furniture and cabinets built, beds and other things on order. While we wait to be ready to open our gardener is supplying the orphanage and many struggling families with fresh vegetables he grew.

Pictured on the left is a young boy who has been suffering a lot with starvation and is in a hospital. He is receiving from us formula, also milk, eggs, peanut butter powder and clothes and treatment for when he is very sick. The hospital cannot afford it.

The home is doing well with the children only having a few sniffles. All the staff are doing a wonderful job of loving and caring for them all.

Thank you for your love and support. We really appreciate how you come along aside us with your end of year giving to help us head into the new year of 2022 which is quickly approaching.
