Laura, Lisa and Lois went home to be with their mum 9 years ago, now need intervention again. We were sad to learn this year that they had not been getting the care they need, and not been educated for the past 3 years. Last week they were interviewed at a boarding school to see if they will accept them with their education gap. We have a scholarship for them from Tennessee. Please help with their other needs.

It was wonderful to have a visit from Zacharia and Joshua while they were on vacation in Southern Cal.

It was a joy this past month to return two children home to their family in the village. Both are healthy.

Our goal is to help the vulnerable children in the best way possible. The home restores the discarded helpless babies, but now we try to prevent children dying or suffering in villages. Our finances are limited, so we are in one village now (surrounding villages come for our help). No one is excluded from help!

Note: The Ugandan Government is trying to help the villages, but they do not have the resources. The local government officials are glad that we step in the gap in many ways to help make sure that the innocent ones do not suffer. We try to keep the children, and their parents healthy so that they able to work (sometimes it is a small expense to keep the parent alive so that they provide for their children - It is cheaper to keep the family intact) We are running Dental and Medical clinics and some family intervention on a regular basis. Medical bills are always there.

Do you have friends who you could ask to help in this humanitarian work?? ALL needy are helped (without regard to religious identity), as funds permit.
