Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

Intervention and restoration is a large part of our ministry and it happens in different ways.

This month we celebrate the life transformation of Elliot. In July 2013 he was admitted into hospital for 2 weeks after being found by Mumma Sol (pictured above) at our first village medical clinic. Elliot was in his late teens dying because of neglected TB of lungs and breast bone. This young man chose a regime of isolation and treatment for a year in our gardener's room (alternative: death). He chose life on more than one level and is now healthy and is a new graduate of Kingdom Life Training Center. He will soon return to his home village as assistant pastor of a new church.

Two young sibling boys have been in our home for three years. Dad had been arrested for a crime he did not commit 4 years ago. After his arrest his wife decided to abandon the two boys. They were admitted to our home. In July we investigated the situation as the dad had spent 4 years in prison with no court hearing. We hired a lawyer to represent the dad, now he is out of prison working to get his life reestablished and will take his two boys home. The boys are excited and are looking forward to joining their dad!!

We have siblings who had been neglected by both parents; we work with our police mumma as the parents are given an opportunity to grow up and be responsible. Pray for things to be safe and clear.
