Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

What a busy month this has been. We had two teams visit from Colorado and Michigan. A medical clinic that attended to 986 people followed by a week long dental clinic. One of our adoptive families came with their children and a team of their friends to serve and care for our children and staff. The big classroom at our Bible School was transformed into a 3 station very busy portable dental clinic. After watching them work, never arm wrestle a dentist!!! Our staff were complimented by the dentists on the condition of the children's teeth as only a few children needed work done. One child had a tantrum because he did not get a filling or a tooth pulled!! The staff are very appreciative of the very loving care they received. A numbed mouth for the work being done was new for many of them. We thank the many sponsors who supplied the team with all the necessary items to run the clinic

The suffering of many children has once again shown itself very clearly. The little boy (bottom left) died with much suffering just 12 hours after we took him to hospital. This is a problem that we are now developing a new program to deal with. Our medical social worker and team are going to be doing village searches for the at-risk children that are falling through the cracks. We want the children to get the needed care, and parents nutritional and work training for an income to sustain the family.
