Life in Uganda is a terrible hardship for so many who live day to day. Many have lost their work. The children suffer the worst. Our village teams are still helping despite travel restriction, our village pastors find needy families - then pictures and information sent by text back to the team in Jinja. The team then evaluate the situation and organize the needed medical and/or nutritional care.

The Corona Virus is now on the move again, spreading in the cities and towns of Uganda. The orphanage is on lock down again to protect the children. The staff are taking Hydroxychloroquine twice a week along with Zinc and Vitamin C to try and stay healthy. We appreciate prayer for them.

Our staff have been doing a wonderful job with the children who have not been off the compound since I think March unless it has been for a medical appointment. Home Schooling is a part of life for now. Keeping the children occupied and not bored is quite a big undertaking. Well done to all the staff!

We continue to have new children coming in. Augustine was brought in by his uncle this past week - he has lost both of his parents and is a full orphan. The probation officer (child protective services) signed for him to be part of our WH family. Please pray for a good future for him.
