The renovation of the main home is completed!!!

Work is continuing on the back house where the smaller babies normally reside and on the outdoor kitchen laundry block. It has been a mammoth task to restore the buildings that were built many years ago before the era of putting in proper foundations. When I arrived at the home the end of September it was a very messy construction site with truckloads of rubbish and old tiles. There was virtually no space for the older children to play safely. All the youngest were housed down at our village pastors school a mile away. It was wonderful to be able to reunite them all into the main house on a Friday afternoon two weeks ago. There was dancing, shouting and singing from the kids.

The past month has been spent cleaning and sorting, donating items we are not using to others who can use them and getting worn out broken down items to the dump. The landscaping all had to be redone so I had fun with that going to the nurseries at the side of the road to get most of the plants thankful that they were sold at Ugandan prices, not American. Our strong men on staff worked for days planting and watering.

The children and the staff are healthy and very happy to be all “home” back into their normal routine.
