A third of our children go home to their remnant families in the villages after they have become healthy and the family is in a position to take care of them. Three on the bottom left hand column go home, two with goats. One third of our children are adopted. The fruit of adoption top right Rachel and her family still keep in contact with us from England. We have four little ones heading to a radical new life in America. One third of our children go to and extension orphanage called Watoto for growing up years.
