We begin a new year with many changes in the Ugandan Government. There has been a lot of UN influence for children to return to their villages, or never leave their village. We do not have to make many adjustments in our ministry since we have always worked this way (except when children's lives would be at risk). Often children come into the home because their mother died in childbirth and the dad does not know what to do with a newborn. We keep the child through to 3 years old, and then return them home to their village (they will settle well at that age). Our little ones need your prayers as their lives are never easy without hassles.
